Donating papers and digital data to ICSOH

The Institute for Community Studies and Oral History at Nipissing University has as its goal the preservation of the historical heritage of the communities and families in North Bay and the Near North region of Ontario. The ICSOH requires donors to agree to the terms and conditions of our gift form (printed below). Papers, photographs, and other non-three dimensional material are accepted into our collection after prior agreement between donor and archives. If the donor believes their papers to have a financial value of more than \$1000.00, an external appraisal for income tax purposes is legally required. It is the responsibility of the donor to arrange and pay for this evaluation. Otherwise, an in-house evaluation may be conducted. For our part, the ICSOH arranges, permanently preserves and makes available to researchers, such materials as are accepted into our care. In the event that the original documents or material is retained by the donor and that the right to copy that material is granted instead, ICSOH nonetheless requires the transfer and donation of the rights to that material in order to make it available to other researchers and to authorize its publication on the internet and elsewhere.
